Daniel Rodriguez

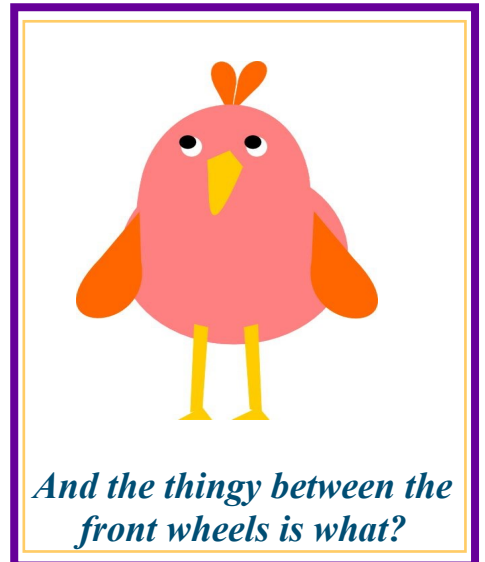
